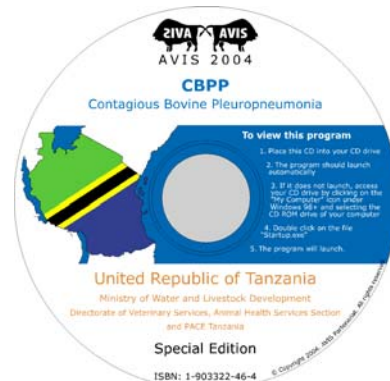
AVIS: The Advanced Veterinary Information System
